

Scholarship Policy

Purpose of the policy

This Policy outlines the principles under which Auswide College offers and manages scholarships to future or current students.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for a scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be enrolled or intending to enrol in a course with Auswide College
- Meet Auswide College Course Entry Requirements
- Demonstrate a commitment to their studies and professional development

Scholarship Conditions

The following conditions must be adhered to in order to maintain the scholarship:

- The recipient must pay each installment of their tuition fee as mentioned in the fee structure.
- The recipient must maintain satisfactory academic course progress.
- The recipient must maintain the required attendance level.
- The recipient is not permitted to hold other Auswide College Scholarships or Grants for the duration of this Scholarship
- The recipient must consent to allowing their name, photograph, and/or a short article to be used for the promotion of Auswide College.
- The recipient must inform Auswide College of any changes to their enrolment status or personal circumstances that may affect their eligibility

Termination of Scholarship

Auswide College reserves the right to terminate a scholarship under the following conditions;

- The recipient ceases to meet the eligibility criteria.
- The recipient breaches any conditions of the scholarship.

If the scholarship is terminated due to breaching any conditions or misconduct, the recipient may be required to reimburse Auswide for any scholarship payments already made.

Appeals Process

Applicants who wish to appeal a scholarship decision must submit the Auswide College complaints and appeals form within 14 days of receiving the decision notification.
